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PROPOSED REGULATIONS FOR NON-REPAIRABLE CERTIFICATE

Insurance company which makes a total loss settlement and takes possession of that vehicle:

1. The original certificate of title showing the "SALVAGE" brand must be surrendered.
2. Statement from a practicing automotive mechanic who reports minimal damage covering all major component parts of the vehicle and summarize estimated cost of each major system and the vehicle as a whole. If the total damage exceeds 50% of the average value of the NADA book or equivalent publication for vehicles.
3. Statement from the insurance company that the vehicle was stolen and now recovered with no damage or damage that does not exceed retail value of vehicle. They must include that they are in agreement and request that the department release the salvage brand.
4. Copy of the police report indication that stolen vehicle was recovered.
5. Applicable fees.
